



BURSARY FUNDING GUIDELINES

1. BACKGROUND

UTT is an industry training and development trust fund that supports the Oil and Gas industry/sector with much needed skills and capacity building. The objective is to build a pipeline of Oil and Gas industry experts that will support the sustainable development of this emerging and critical industry

It is a bursary fund targeted at university/tertiary students that are pursuing studies in the following key areas:

Chemistry; Geology; Geophysics; Engineering; Environmental Science; Information Technology/Systems; Mathematics.

2. INTRODUCTION

Below are the guidelines to assist prospective bursary and project funding recipients.

2.1 Bursary application guidelines

Who can apply:

- Grade 12 learners who are currently in their final academic year.

- Students currently enrolled at institutions of higher learning in South Africa who require financial assistance.
- Individuals who have completed their National Senior Certificate (Matric) and either currently pursuing or intend to pursue related qualifications at recognised institutions of higher learning in South Africa.

2.2 Eligibility criteria:

To be considered for the bursary, applicants must:

- Be a South African citizen.
- Preferably apply online through the website.
- Be registered or conditionally accepted at an institution of higher learning.
- Achieve a minimum overall pass mark of 60% and a minimum pass of 65% in Mathematics, Science, and English.
- Not be in receipt of another bursary or financial assistance.

Preference will be given to applications from previously disadvantaged groups with a household income of R350,000 or less.

2.3 Guidelines for completing the online form:

- Read the guidelines before completing and submitting your application form.
- Applicants should select on qualification they are applying for.
- Submit only one application per applicant.
